- Performing quality checks on completed products.

- Operates forklift to load/unload trucks and trailers.
- Perform basic maintenance
 - o Inspection/maintenance of shop tools and equipment.
 - o Perform basic maintenance on trailers and vehicles such as brakes, lights, service, etc.
